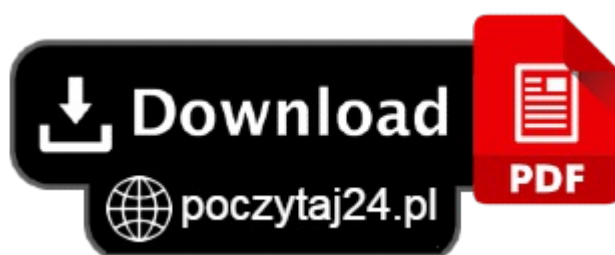


Edgar Jepson

This early work was originally a four-act play written by Maurice Leblanc and Francis de Croisset in 1908, and subsequently novelized by Leblanc and then translated by Edgar Jepson into English and published in 1909.

In this classic tale, Lupin plans to steal priceless objects of art and jewelry from a collector for his own private collection.
